The Russian Institute of Economic Strategies and ‘Economic Strategies’ magazine have named Volga-Dnepr Group as their ‘Company of the Year 2004’.



The prestigious award was presented in recognition of the fast realisation by Volga-Dnepr of its strategic potential.
